- Heelys, backpacks and food are not allowed in the conservatory. Lockers are provided near the restrooms in the Welcome Center for your use.
- Appropriate attire, including shirts and shoes, must be worn at all times.
- The garden and its employees are not responsible for any loss or damage to personal items.
- Unruly or indecent behavior is grounds for removal from the gardens.

Photography

Phipps Conservatory encourages photography and the use of video cameras for personal use. Tripods are not permitted. Commercial photography requires prior approval and may require a fee. Commercial photography includes, but is not limited to wedding photography, professional portraits, modeling, media, and images for resale in any form. For Your Safety

- Phipps can be very warm during the summer months and some rooms may be cool during the winter. Visitors are encouraged to dress in layers year-round and make use of the lockers in the Welcome Center when necessary.
- Most of the walkways at Phipps are concrete or stone. Some may be uneven and slippery when wet. Comfortable, slip-resistant shoes are recommended for your safety and enjoyment.
- The Stove Room is not accessible by wheelchair or those who need assistance walking.
- The Tropical Forest Conservatory is accessible by wheelchair but does require a return trip up a gentle grade.

Outdoor Garden

Admission to Phipps includes access to all interior rooms and the Children's Discovery and Japanese gardens. The large Outdoor Garden is part of our rental program and is often occupied for special events. If the Outdoor Garden is available, it is accessible at no extra charge to Conservatory visitors.

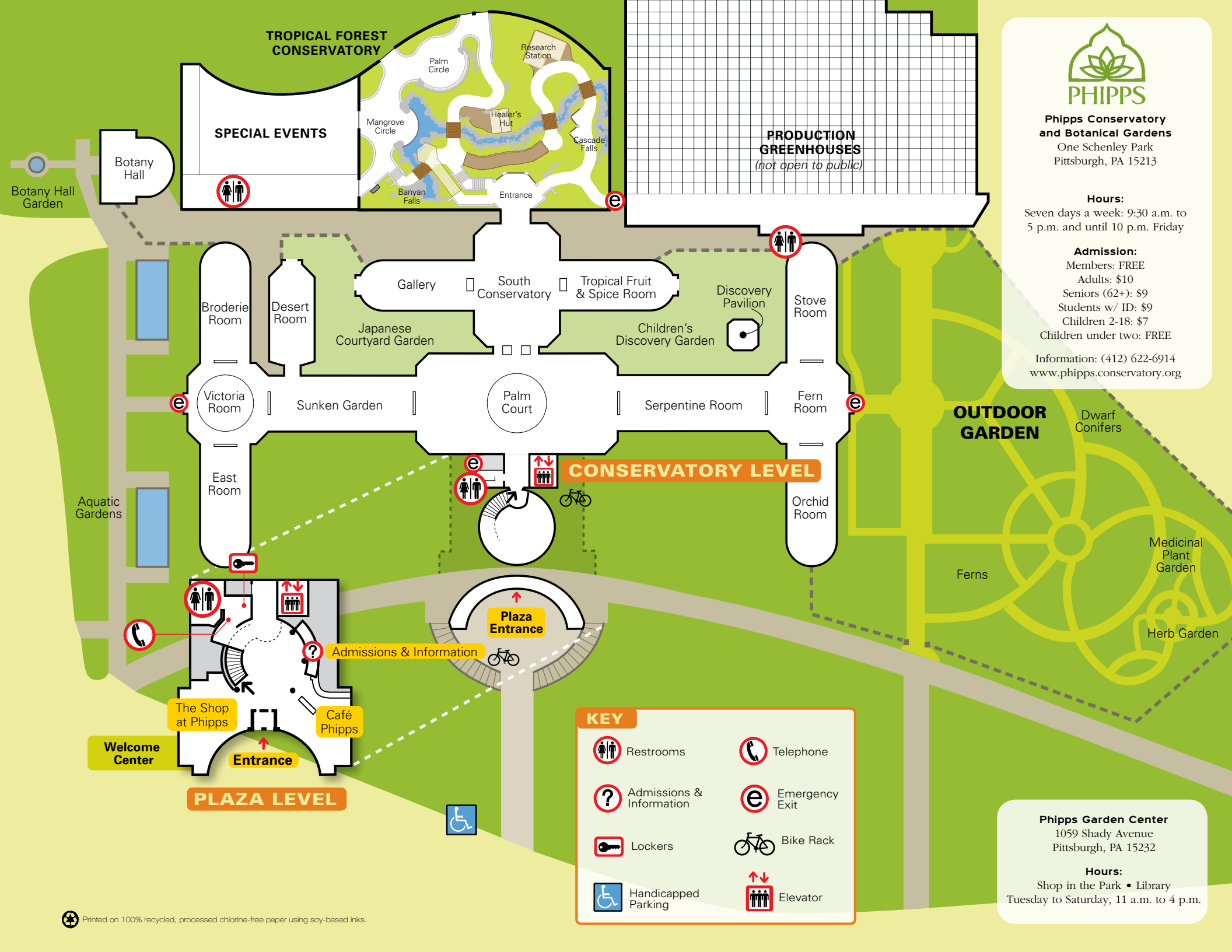
