Supply List for Watercolor Drybrush/ Limning Techniques

Watercolor paints
Any brand/grade you prefer.

Brushes:

- Very fine pointed, round brush – size 00, 0, or 1.
- Wash brush, for putting down paint in a large area.

Paper

- White hot press watercolor paper, or any smooth-surfaced paper that will take wet media, ex. Stonehenge printing paper.
- Any other paper you prefer for practice
- Sketch paper
- Tracing paper

Palette

Whatever type you like. I use porcelain saucers and dishes, but anything that you're used to is fine.

Pencils (any type, for sketching).

Erasers (vinyl, rubber, or whatever you prefer). I do recommend having a kneadable eraser, it will be good for lightening pencil lines.

Water container, though having two is suggested.
